## "Responsibility" to people: Turner

he feels it is now appropriate for him to adopt his personal position.

"I think I have a responsibility to tell people where I stand. I don't think I should be hiding on this."

Turner based his yes vote on five reasons: economic considerations, the slim chance of a consensus report ever being reached again, the myth that a No vote will be without consequences, that it's a referendum not an election, and finally, that it's time to end the constitutional furor and focus on other issues.

"The world's financial markets clearly indicate they think we

should vote yes," Turner said.

He accused Trudeau of trivializing the issue.

"It's not Mulroney's deal," said Turner. "Every government in the country - it's their deal. Separatists want us to vote no...I want to remind the people of Halton-Peel of that. Take the fire out of the separatists' bellies...I think Quebeckers are looking for a loveletter from the rest of Canada."

"I've listened to all the no arguments and I have not been convinced," Turner said. "My public opinion poll [the public meetings] tells me that most people want to vote yes. In referenda in general

the no side is sexier...it's trendy to vote no."

What doesn't Turner like in the Charlottetown agreement?

Turner didn't want a social charter (the Social Union part), doesn't think Senators should be elected by the provincial legislatures, doesn't support gender equality "quotas", and fought for property rights, which aren't included in the agreement.

"Is it enough to vote no? I don't think so," Turner said. "Are eleven governments ever going to come to a better decision?"


