

Breeders' championships highlight card

The Canadian Breeders Championships highlighted the weekend card of racing at Mohawk as eight divisional events totaling over \$640,000 in purse money went postward over two nights of racing action.

Image of Beauty, a daughter of Balanced Image continued her winning ways on Sat. night in the \$66,550 CBC Final for sophomore trotting fillies.

Reinsman Larry Walker guided her to a gate-to-wire 2:00.4 victory for trainer Brian Burton, owners Ed Weisz and William Friedman. It was her 11th win in 14 starts and increased her bank account to \$139,772.

Trainer Brian Burton confided that Image of Beauty will probably be sold to European interests at the conclusion of the year.

A thoughtful dive and some fancy stickhandling proved profitable for driver Mike Saftic in the \$89,650 CBC for sophomore pacing fillies as he guided Briar Dream to a 1:56 effort over Shipp's Showboat and Downburst.

Saftic and Briar Dream followed

Playbreeze from the gate and it looked like they were going to take command but Saftic decided to put his filly in the pocket position. Midway through the lane Briar Dream was locked in third when Saftic maneuvered her through a small opening enroute to pacing past Playbreeze.

"I thought I might get past Playbreeze but she was going lots at the quarter," said Saftic, referring to the :27.3 opening panel. "I was lucky to squeeze out down the lane. This is a talented filly. She cracked a knee at two but trained down well."

Driven By Design came first up against pacesetter Did I Say So enroute to a 1:55.1 victory over Black Pyjamas and Regal Stance in the \$90,050 CBC for sophomore pacing colts and geldings for driver Paul MacDonell.

Trained by Blair Burgess for Cantario Farms, AFJ Stable, and Fred Brunner, it was the Coal Harbor Colt's 7th win in 25 trips postward this year and increased his bank account to over \$400,000 in season's earnings.

It was only MacDonell's second time behind Driven By Design who admitted that the colt paced well within himself and required no urging.

An untimely break midway through the stretch cost Earl the victory in the \$82,650 CBC Final for sophomore trotting colts. Armbró Kelvin who was trotting gamely through the stretch managed to overtake the Balanced Image colt and get up for the win.

The Dream of Glory colt, trained and driven by Jim Whelan for

Norman Vartanian of Stoney Creek has had a tough year. It was only his 8th start in a year marred by sickness. "We were very pleased with him but not surprised", explained Vartanian, "this colt is only at 60% of his ability right now. He has not recovered fully from his sickness earlier this year".

Earl managed to hang on for place money and Norwell Sweetness was third.

On Sunday night the freshmen divisions of The Canadian Breeders Championships went postward.

Armbró Leader, a royally bred son of Balanced Image scored his 8th win in 14 starts for trainer-driver-owner Bill Wellwood in the CBC for two year old trotting colts and geldings.

It was another typical performance for Armbró Leader who has dominated his class all year and was four and a quarter lengths the best on this night, stopping the clock in 2:01 to take the lion's share of the \$62,756 event.

Armbró Libra, an Armbró Emerson filly highstepped a 2:01 effort in the \$79,889 event for two year old pacing fillies over Reef The Table and Family Choice.

Driver Doug Brown reined the talented filly to a wire-to-wire three-quarter length win for trainer-co-owner Ted Huntbach and owners George Judson and Spender Baynham.

According to Huntbach, bad luck has cost the filly a lot of money this year. "She's the type of filly that should have \$150,000 on her card by now. She got gravel in her foot and we missed a Gold (Ontario Sires Stakes event) in Orangeville".

Daylon Leader took over past a :28.2 opening quarter and never looked back to pace to a 1:57.3 two length win in the \$88,113 CBC Final for rookie pacing colts for driver Trevor Ritchie, trainer Wayne Presczator and Jade River Stable of Toronto.

RELINING DENTURES

Loose dentures on a resorbed jaw bone cause the distance between the nose and chin to become too short. As a result, the mouth and lip muscles sag, therefore causing the skin to become wrinkled and lined. The answer to this problem is either new dentures or "relining". If your dentures are under 5 years old, relining is probably the answer.

With relining, impressions are taken of the gums and bone as they are now. New plastic is added inside the dentures so they adapt to the new jaw contours. This makes the lips and cheeks fuller, therefore some of the wrinkles actually become "ironed out". It also makes the denture fit more snug to the gums, so that the denture becomes tighter.

Your gums are constantly changing and shrinking of the gums can create sharp ridges forming, because of the pressure of the denture. This can cause considerable discomfort, and can lead to permanent gum damage. Relining your denture is a quick, inexpensive way of giving you much needed comfort.

Your denture and mouth tissues should be checked once a year, as ill fitting dentures can lead to various health problems.
