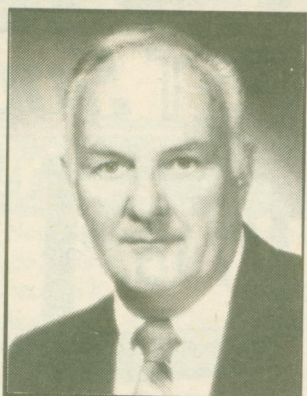

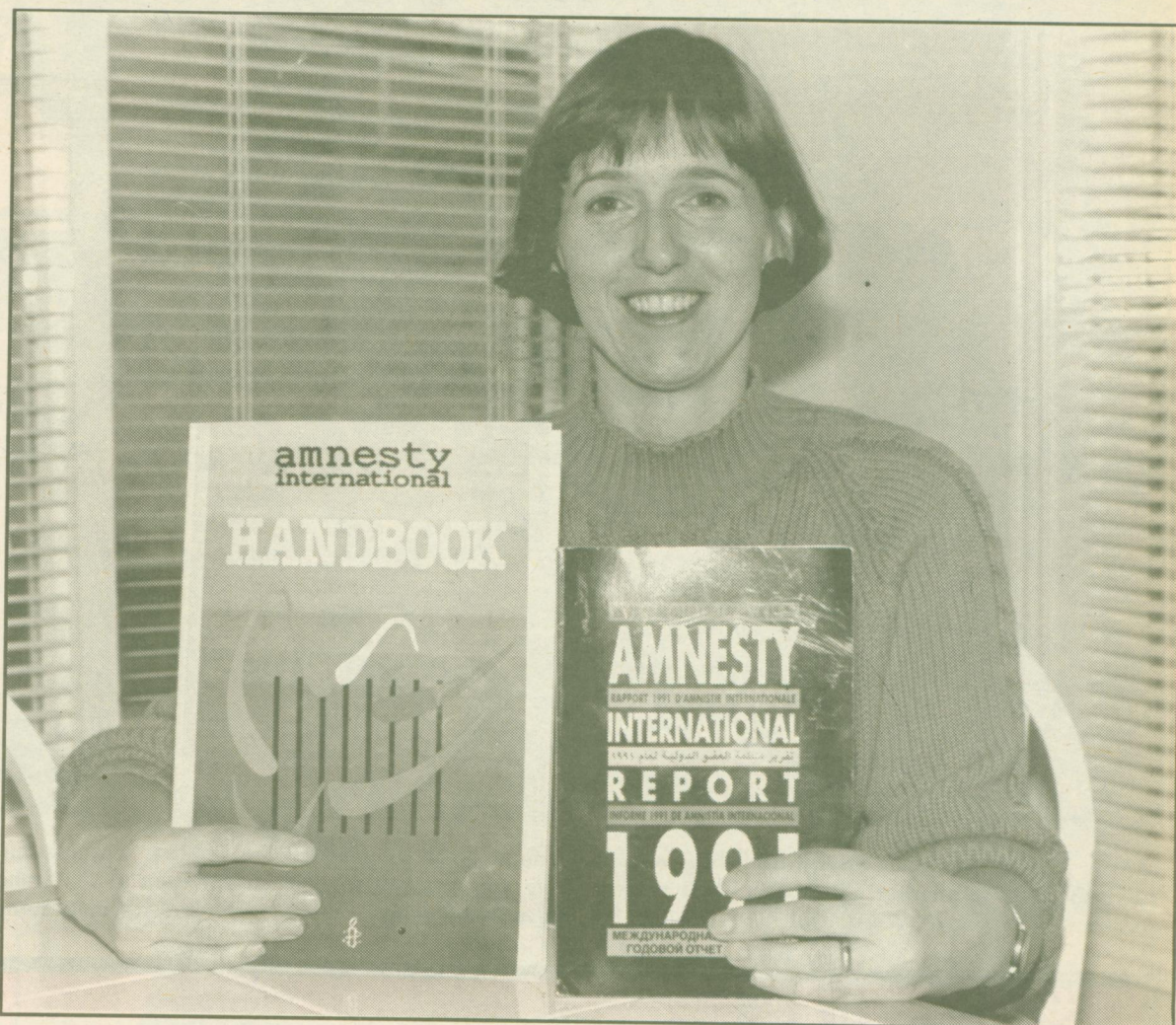

## Amnesty International in Halton Hills

Human rights are something we seldom think about because, as average Canadians, our basic

human rights are protected and implemented.

In many countries in the world, people are jailed for merely voicing

opinions contrary to the government in power, or are unjustly tortured and exposed to political cruelty based on their beliefs, color, sex, ethnic origin, language or religion.

Think, for example, of the summer of 1989 when the Chinese government opened fire on students protesting for democracy in Tiananmen Square. Thousands died.

These are the concerns of Amnesty International. A Halton Hills branch of this organization was formed in March 1991 by Cheryl Broughton.

Since then, the Halton Hills Amnesty International has rounded up a membership of about 50 with a core of 15 active members.

"As soon as I saw it I knew it was something I wanted to be a part of," said Kathy Hall, who now fulfills a role as co-ordinator and member education chairperson for the local group. "I've always been opposed to cruelty in all its forms. Even if it was a bully picking on the other kids in the schoolyard, I'd be right in there because I couldn't bear it...As long as I've got breath in my body I won't stand for it."

Amnesty International's mandate includes facilitating the right not to be tortured, ill-treated or executed, and ending the grave violations of fundamental human rights. They strive to end the death penalty (in all cases, even for the Ted Bundys of the world) and other cruel treatment of prisoners of conscience. (Amnesty emphasizes that they do not defend those jailed because of violence or terrorist acts.)

They also advocate fair and speedy trials for all political prisoners.
