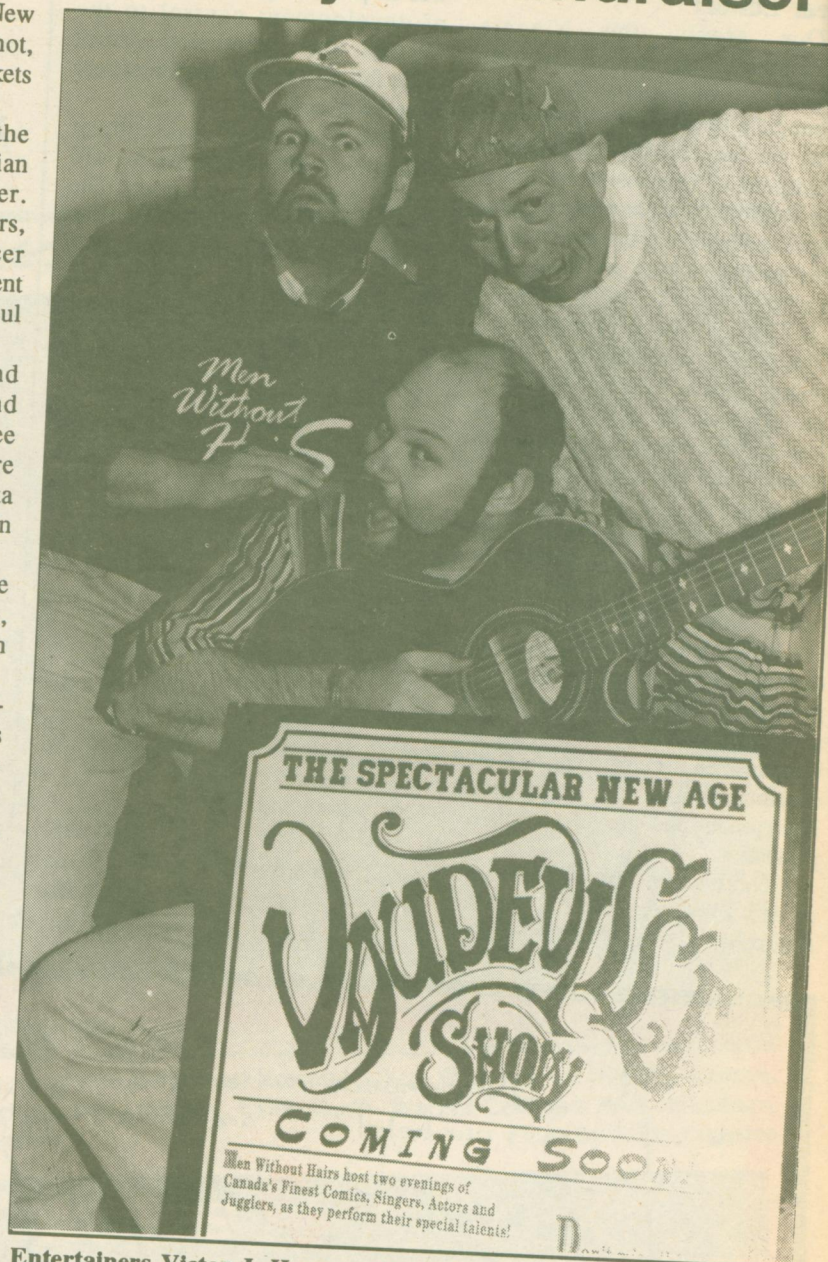

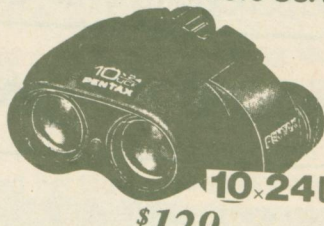

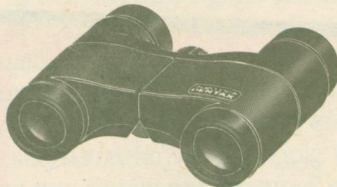

where her focus was on individual development and family systems.

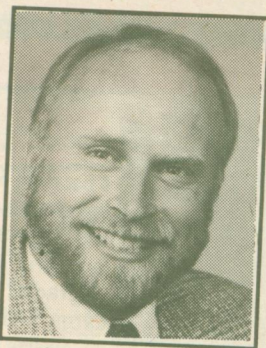
