DEAR HURT:

For these "friends" to have invited your husband to dinner and excluded you is the height of ignorance and insensitivity.

And for Ricardo to have accepted, leaving you home, shows him

to be shamefully inconsiderate of your feelings.

You don't say how long you've been married or whether you have children, but if you tolerate this kind of demeaning treatment, you can expect more of the same in the future.

Unless you are willing to settle for a "master-slave" relationship, I urge you to (a) learn to speak Spanish, and (b) seek marriage counseling, either from your clergyman or a licensed professional counselor.

If Ricardo refuses to do, go without him. Please do not tolerate this abusive behavior. It will only get worse. Trust me.
