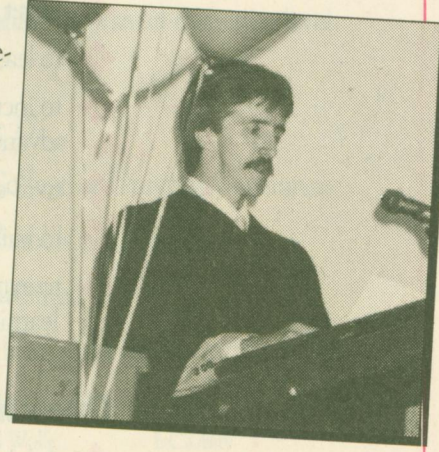


Good News!

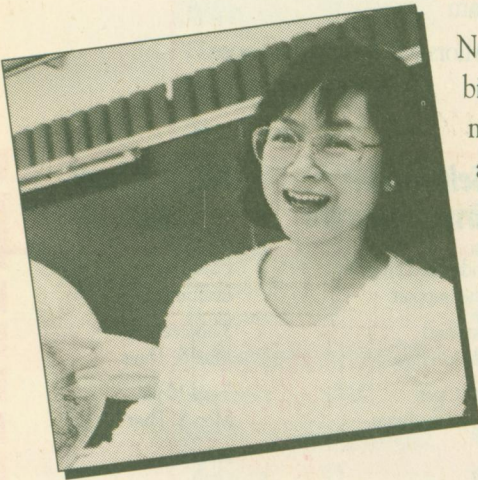
