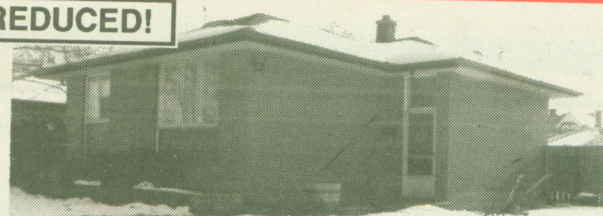

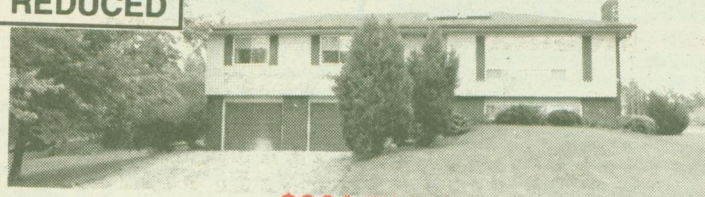

Smoke Kills

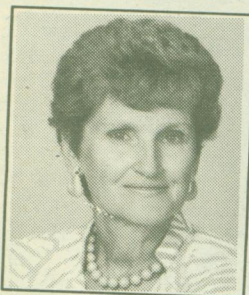
