## Georgetown triumphs over rival Chinguacousy team

On Wednesday, January 6, the John Henderson Pro Shop Major Atoms travelled to Chinguacousy to play an evenly-matched Ching squad.

Excellent goaltending at both ends kept the first period scoreless. Ryan Carter made two good glove saves for the Raiders while Sean Muscat was turned away after a great three-way passing play from Jason Campbell and Mike Rovere.

Dan Smith opened the scoring

with a short-handed marker just 54 seconds into the second period. Matt Hotham assisted. Ching tied the game at 2:48.

Chinguacousy penalties gave Georgetown a two-man advantage with four minutes remaining in the middle frame. Five seconds after the face-off, Roddy Heinz deflected Brent McClung's shot from the point to give Georgetown a 2-1 lead.

Fine defensive work by the tan-

dem of Bryan Stuttard and Derek Mitchell helped preserve our lead. Ching scored two quick goals in the third to take a 3-2 lead.

Dan Smith tied the game at the 7:30 mark by slamming in a Roddy Heinz rebound. Heinz scored the go-ahead goal, his second of the game, with 3:58 remaining. Assists went to Hotham and Smith.

After being stopped on an earlier breakaway, Mike Rovere found himself alone in front of the Ching goaler and scored an insurance marker with 3:06 remaining. The line of Ryan Bobor, Jason Hayes and Josh Travers kept the Ching forwards in check late in the game.

Defensive plays by Scott Ellis and a great pad save by Ryan Carter held off the Ching attack until they pulled within one goal with 52 seconds remaining. Final score was Georgetown 5, Ching 4.

## Minor Raiders suffer pair of tough tri-county losses

The Minor Novice Raiders were in tough this week against two tri-county teams, Brampton and Oakville.

In Brampton the Raiders put on a good show for the first two periods. Brampton struck first with an even strength goal midway through the first, but Georgetown replied early in the second with a goal off the stick of Adam Kemp.

The line of Andrew McGourdy, Brett Velten and Kemp were all over the Brampton squad with good forechecking, and finally Kemp fired a low shot through the five hole to tie the game, assists going to Velten and McGourdy. In the third the Brampton squad forced Georgetown into some defensive zone errors and came back with three unanswered goals. Final score was Brampton 4, Georgetown 1.

On Sunday a strong Oakville team visited the Junior Raiders and outplayed what looked like a tired Raider team, with the score ending 6-1 for the visitors.

One bright spot was a nice rush by Adam Kemp, when he picked up a pass at the Georgetown blue line from Andy Burns, Kemp went down with Brett Velten on the right side against the two Oakville defenders.

Kemp faked to the inside drawing the defense man out of position and went outside around both defenders and using Velten as a decoy. He fired a high shot off the goalie's chest pad and in for Georgetown's lone goal.

### DENTURES - "SORE SPOTS"

The main reason for having sore spots is illfitting dentures. Your mouth is constantly changing and your gums are constantly shrinking. Also, denture wear causes discomfort. It is always important to note that an illfitting denture does not have to be a worn out "old" denture. It is possible to have a new denture that is illfitting, but for many different reasons. It might not have been made right from the start.

#### OTHER REASONS FOR HAVING SORE SPOTS

As you get older, your body goes through many changes. Tissue can become more sensitive to pressure which can cause irritation.

Medication can give you a "dry mouth". This makes it more difficult for the denture to suction to the roof of your mouth. It also can cause rubbing which causes sore spots.

If you have recently lost weight, your gums also become smaller. This can also cause sore spots.

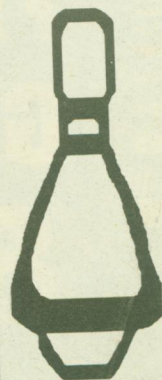
