money, but it has caused us to run over budget" Councillor Norm Elliott said Monday while commenting on the staff report. "We must be in the neighborhood of \$600,000 to \$700,000" in total costs associated with the landfill site, he suggested.

"The money we have spent on this is close to what is needed for (building) an Acton arena," Mayor Miller observed.

Councillor Marilyn Serjeantson said town councillors must continue to stress that Halton Region was responsible in its approach for locating a waste management site in Halton. However, the rules of "the process" for Environmental Assessment (EA) don't appear to be the same for other players, she said.

Councillor Al Cook asked Costea if it's conceivable that the town might be facing costs of \$300,000 or more in the continuing landfill fight this year. "It is conceivable," Costea replied.

Referring to the money spent on fighting the dumpsite proposal to date, Cook commented: "That sure


would have built a nice seniors' building."

Councillor Rick Bonnette told town council members that Halton regional councillor has put its support behind a Brampton council resolution calling for the resignation of Ontario environment minister Ruth Grier. Two weeks ago, Halton Hills Town Council decided to refer the same request for support to the town's solicitor for consideration.

Bonnette expressed his hope that the solicitor's response would be positive and the town will join others in supporting the Brampton
