Canada, and especially in Ontario." Yacoub says the problems stem from people making incorrect assumptions about others.

"There are too many misconceptions. People put their own interpretations on issues and don't seem to base it on the real facts. The employment equity legislation is meant to be inclusive not exclusive. The intent was to give a proper representation to women, to minorities, to natives, to the physically and mentally challenged," said Yacoub.
