Bryan Gendron led the offensive fireworks with three goals. The former Peterborough Pete, who rejoined the Raiders earlier this season after wanting out of the Owen Sound Platers' organization (the team he was traded to earlier in the Ontario Hockey League season as an over-age forward) ensured the fabled Georgetown collapse wouldn't happen in the third period, scoring two of his goals in the final 20 minutes.

Ian Ellis also had a big hand in the Raiders' offensive onslaught

with two goals and two assists. Defencemen Jeff Churney and Chris Arro had the other goals for Georgetown.

Churney and Gendron scored first-period goals as the Raiders took a 2-1 advantage into the second. Once again, Georgetown outscored their rivals 2-1, with Ellis and Arro doing the honors, to take a two-goal lead into the third.

Georgetown resumes league play this weekend. On Friday night the team was in Burlington to meet the Cougars, then hosts Burlington tonight at the Alcott Arena (7:30 p.m., faceoff time) to complete the home-and-home series.

In addition, Raider forward

Trevor Brandt will be taking part in the Central Ontario Hockey League all-star game, which will be held Saturday afternoon in Burlington. Brandt, the Raiders' leading scorer so far this season, will suit up for the West team. Georgetown defenceman Steve Weishar is also an alternate for the West squad.

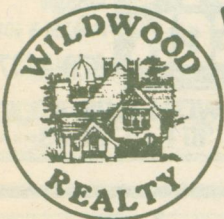

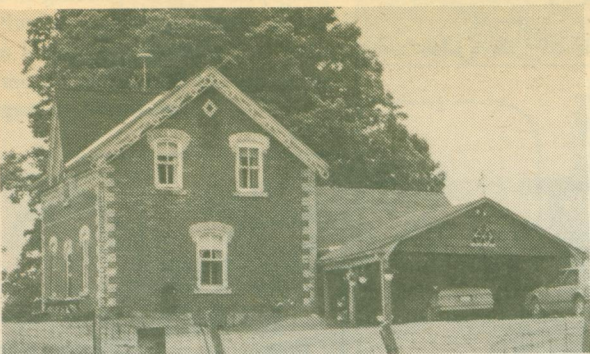
Coaches are needed for the boys, U-11, U-13, U-15 & U-19 age divisions.

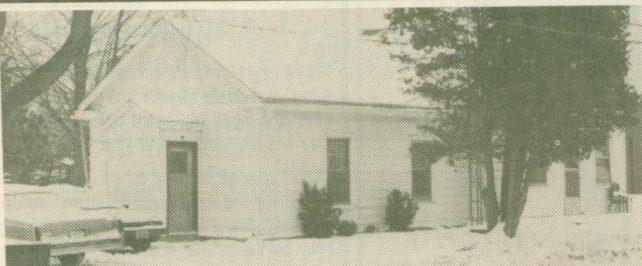

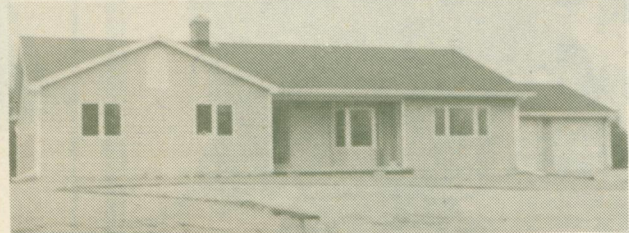

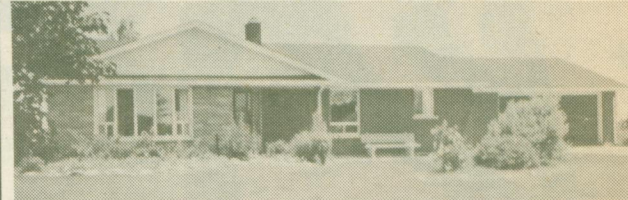
