Town and Region withdraw support of Wastewise

Wastewise was notified on Tuesday, January 19 that their last pickup for Blue Box materials would be January 25. This service is being revoked despite a promise from the Town on October 26, 1992 to continue collecting these materials. Service for the Civic Centre, the hospital and others has also been affected. At present, Wastewise receives no support of any kind from the Town of Halton Hills or Halton Region.

During the past week Wastewise has requested action from Town staff, Regional staff, the Town administrator, councillors and the Mayor. They are hoping that their efforts will result in continued collection. However, it appears that the Town has no choice but to dis-

continue this service. With the hope of appealing to Council, Wastewise has asked to be placed on the Council agenda as a delegation on February 8, 1993. Area residents are welcome to listen to this presentation at the Civic Centre.
