
AFSC members shine in competitions

GRIPS - Part II

As stated in part I the grip provides the golfe with the only physical contact with the golf club. Therefore it is most important the golfer has the proper grip size. Properly sized grips give the golfer a comfortable feeling at address, positive control during the swing and does not inhibit wrist action. If the club (grip) doesn't feel right in the player's hand then it obviously won't feel good as they make the

The standard rule in the industry in selecting grip size is that when the anchor hand is in the grip (left hand for right handed players and right hand for left handed players) the ring and middle fingers should be no more than one sixteenth of an inch away from the base of your hand. If they are further away than that the grip is too large. If your fingernails are digging into your palm the grip is too small. Golfers as a whole are not aware that grips can be installed in different sizes and that different variations of grip sizes are possible under the left hand vs. the right hand.

When you next have your clubs regripped take the time to evaluate grip size.
