Stolen property unearthed in cemetery

Halton Regional Police were led to a quiet, deserted, village cemetery last week in their search for a stolen cache of valuable jewels and

A nine-month old Belfountain burglary case was partly solved when a Norval teen led police to a buried stash in the old Norval Cemetery on Winston Churchill Dr.

Police Beat

The Caledon OPP began the investigation on May 26, 1992 after receiving a a break and enter call from a home in Belfountain. The owners had just returned from a vacation to discover, in their absence, someone had broken into their home and stolen

their 250 pound safe containing jewelry and rare coins, valued at over \$80,000.

Some of the stolen property was recovered in October of last year when a Norval woman called Halton Police after discovering jewelry and coins in her grandson's room. However, the source of the stolen property at that time was unknown.

Last Wednesday Halton Police received information from the Caledon OPP, verifying the source. They brought the eighteen-year-old from Norval in for questioning and he, in turn, led them to the Norval cemetery. Halton Public Works were called in and a jackhammer broke the frozen ground to unearth the safe, with most of the jewelry and coins intact.

Some of the pieces of jewelry are still missing and police are continuing their investigation. The Norval teen has been charged with possession of stolen property.

Under the gun
