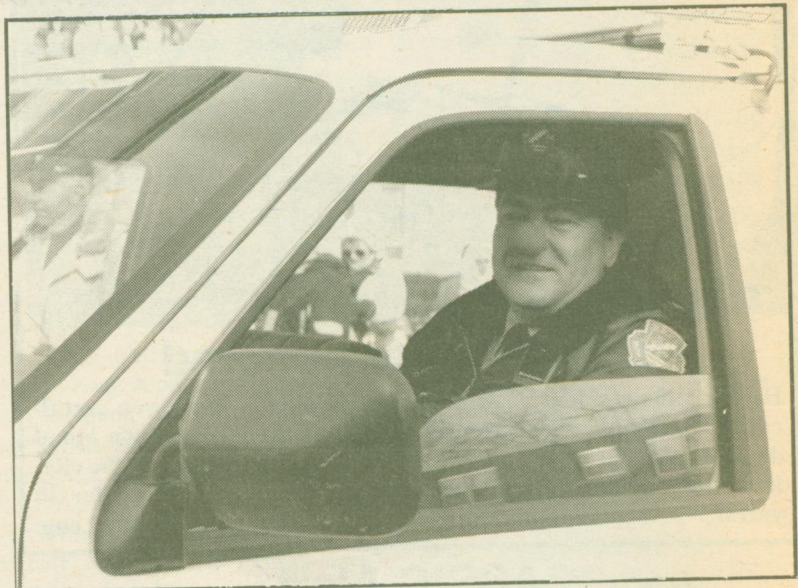


Here's looking at Halton Hills
