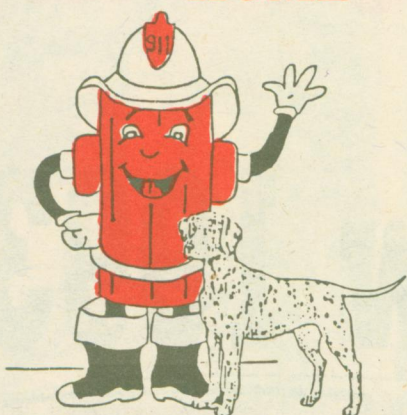
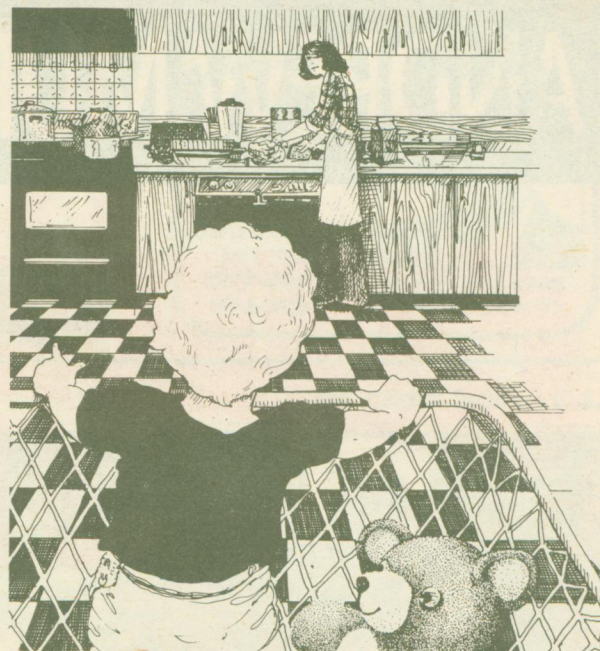

Blue Fins make waves

Halton Hills Blue Fins began the new year by attending the Oakville Winter Invitational on January 8-10. Ten swimmers took part with great results. Seven new club records were set by Matthew Hardstaff, Michael White, Nick Jamotte and Laurie Anne Crocker. Patrick Potosky (9) placed 3rd in 100 back and 6th in 50 back; Laurie Anne Crocker (13) with a 4th in both the 100 and 200 back and Nick Jamotte (15) placed 5th in the 200 fly. This meet was also attended by Alex Main, Christianne Lent, Lauren Potosky, Amy Willis and David McDonald, all of whom set personal best times. All the hard work at the Winter Training Camp we held at the Milton Leisure Centre over Christmas certainly paid off.

On January 24, the Blue Fins hosted a "C" meet with teams from Milton, Alderwood and Orangeville in attendance. Thirty-three Blue Fins entered this meet for a total of 135 swims of which 77 individual awards and nine relay awards were obtained with a total of 107 personal bests. Outstanding results were achieved by all swimmers. Some of these were: Aaron Scarlett - 3 firsts, 2 seconds; James Moore - 2 firsts, 3 seconds, one club record; Erin Shillington - 1 first, 3 seconds, 1 third; John Moore - 1 first, 3 seconds, 1 third. Receiving personal bests for all five events were: Kim Willis, Ashley Besner, Danny Collins and Ian Cunningham. Out thanks to the Royal Canadian Legion, Branch 120, for sponsoring this meet.

January 30 and 31 saw our four senior swimmers, Laurie Anne Crocker, Nick Jamotte, Michael White and Matthew Hardstaff, compete in the Pepsi "Ironman" meet in Etobicoke. This was the first long distance meet Blue Fins have attended and they did us proud by setting new club records in the 400 and 800 free and 400 IM.
