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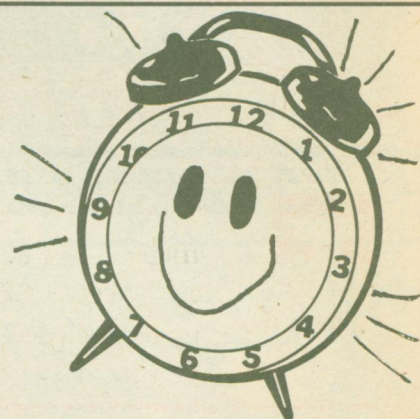

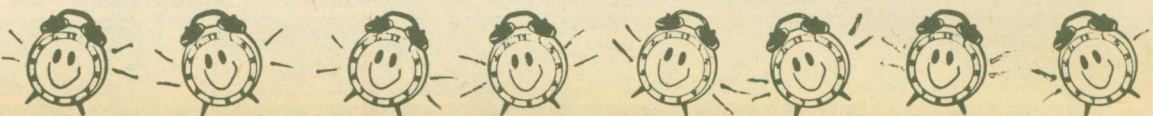

A Trust member set two major media happenings, of utter disinterest. He had conducted a survey, trying to locate people who were actually

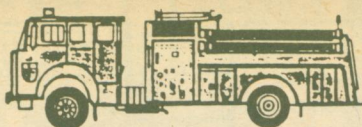

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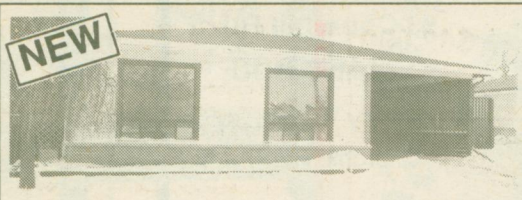
