Schools get provincial grants

Last month, in January, Minister of Education Tony Silipo announced that \$14 million will be provided to central Ontario school boards for various improvement projects through the government's jobsOntarioCapital fund.

The Halton Hills schools that are affected by these measures are McKenzie-Smith Middle School in Acton and Holy Cross in Georgetown.

Holy Cross will receive roofing improvements worth \$80,000. The provincial grant toward this is estimated at \$59,601, according to Ministry documents.

McKenzie-Smith is receiving renovations to its industrial arts area. The estimated costs of these renovations is \$52,000. The province will kick in \$28,903 of this, with the board picking up the rest of the tab.

Teachers at McKenzie-Smith estimate that beyond replacing the floor the industrial arts room has gone unchanged for 40 years.

Industrial arts teacher Tom Travis explained that the renovations will create a classroom within the industrial arts room. The classroom will have windows looking out to the work area. As well, a window and fire door will be placed in two corners.

The long-term hope is to have CAD computers for students to use within the classroom and be taught up-to-date design technology.

Work is scheduled to begin in the industrial arts area at McKenzie-

Smith next week, with completion scheduled by the end of March, according to Ministry stipulations.

Ontario schools include improved access for persons with disabilities, asbestos removal, electrical and fire safety upgrading.

Fabric Care TIPS

~ Thirty-second of a Series ~

UNACCUSTOMED TO SHRINKAGE?

You may have purchased fabric and had draperies custom made for your living room. Later, you send the draperies to your drycleaner for cleaning and finishing. When they are returned, you notice that there is extensive shrinkage and you blame the drycleaner for the damage.

Your cleaner asks you if you have an original sample of the material, which you have. It is carefully measured and then drycleaned and finished, after which it shows the same degree of shrinkage.



Many fabrics sold in bolt form are not completely preshrunk. Consequently, before these fabrics are used to make draperies, they should be drycleaned or washed, depending on the care instructions. A complete drycleaning and finishing or washing, tumble drying, and finishing will help relax the fabric, thus avoiding the unfortunate situation of shrinkage in the finished product.
