### Queen's Park Report

New agencies announced

Last week I mentioned the creation of the Ontario Transportation Capital Corporation and its role in the financing of major public transit and highway construction projects. Two other Crown corporations were also announced by Premier Bob Rae earlier this month — the Ontario Realty Corporation and the Ontario Clean Water Agency.

The primary goal of the Ontario Clean Water Agency will be to help municipalities plan and develop water and sewage services in a way that protects human health and the environment. This new Crown corporation will encourage the conservation of resources by promoting efficient use of existing facilities and will support provincial land use planning and growth and settlement objectives.

The agency will operate and maintain existing provinciallyowned water and sewage facilities throughout Ontario and will develop new facilities, as needed, to meet future water and sewer demands. It will enter into partnership with local governments by providing assistance for upgrading and new development of municipal water and sewer services. And it will help coordinate and finance large projects shared by neighboring municipalities.

A clean, healthy environment requires an efficient system of sewage treatment and an adequate supply of clean water. The Ontario Clean Water Agency will assist municipalities to ensure that all treatment facilities meet environmental objectives and pursue water conservation.

Studies have shown that water use has been increasing every year because of inefficiency, wastefulness and population growth. Ontario municipalities will double their per capita use of water and related energy by 2011 if we continue to use water the way we have to date. Promoting cater conservation will be a strong part of the mandate of the new agency. Greater water efficiency will reduce the need for water treatment.

The province currently owns and/or operates 153 water treatment Noel Duignan MPP **Halton North** 

plants and 77 sewage treatment plants. It also operates 116 municipally-owned water and sewer facilities. Ownership and/or operation will be transferred to the new

Efficient, cost effective water and sewage services are critical to the success of our government's overall Clean Water program including the Municipal-Industrial Strategy for Abatement (MISA) and Remedial Action Plans (RAPS) directed at the cleanup of the Great Lakes.

Provincial planning policies and guidelines will be used by the Ontario Clean Water Agency to ensure environmentally sound and economically viable development. The agency will contribute to good planning by working with municipalities to determine their sewer and water infrastructure needs. It will also assist in the design and construction of new water and sewage facilities and the upgrading of existing facilities.

Environmentally sound development, supported by a local official plan, requires fully serviced land. The Ontario Clean Water Agency will contribute to improved planning practices so local governments are better positioned to manage
