A win in the next game would see the Hurricanes advance to play the AAA Southern League winners.

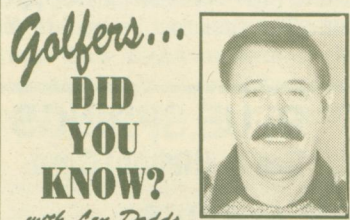

Golfers... DID YOU KNOW?

SHAFTS
The golf shaft's purpose is to bring the clubhead into the proper impact position with the most consistency swing after swing. To do this, the shaft must have the proper flexibility, flex point, torque, material and weight, and length, for the individual golfer.

Flexibility is the measure of stiffness or resistance to bending when comparing one shaft to another.

The flex point is where the shaft will bend most during the swing, such as the tip area, middle of the shaft or the butt area of the shaft.

The material and weight of a shaft helps determine the weight distribution of the club required to obtain a certain swing-weight.

Torque is the amount of twist in a golf shaft through impact.

Technology has given the golfer a greater amount of choice when selecting his or her shafts. In future articles, I will discuss this technology as well as the elements I have mentioned above.

And, as the unknown golfer says:
"Always throw your clubs ahead of you. That way, you save energy by not having to go back to pick them up!"
