## Tempers flare over escarpment

Mittwollen told council that EAGLE collected over 240 names on a petition two weekends ago at the Georgetown Marketplace. Petition-signers support retention of development control in the hands of the NEC.

Today's taxpayers have "less and less money to spend," Mittwollen said, adding that Halton Hills residents won't welcome double taxation which might occur if the Region takes on development control but NEC staff isn't decreased but simply redeployed, as is suggested as a possibility in the regional report.

Turkstra said a former NEC planner told the region's planning committee last week that if application

permit fees are charged, "there would be no net cost to the Region (for the transfer of development control). He further argued that money will be saved if developers have just "one place to go" (to a regional municipality) for approval

rather than continuing the duplication that exists through the NEC process. Regional and municipal planners are asked to comment on development applications being considered by the NEC.

Councillors Gail Rutherford and Kathy Gastle expressed disappointment that the regional proposal couldn't be fully debated at town council because town councillors don't have sufficient information from the region about the proposal.
