# Halton League season is rapidly running out

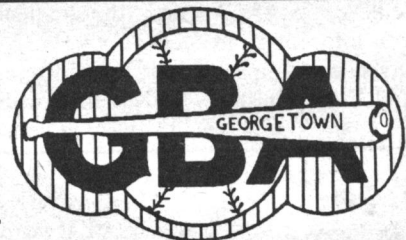
