Fero Waste Hurricanes eye title

The Halton Fero Waste Disposal AAA Minor Atom Hurricanes have earned their way into the OMHA, All-Ontario Finals.

The win came at the expense of the Hamilton Huskies, in the fifth game of a hard-fought series.

The Huskies came out strong in the first game, at Hamilton's Rosedale Arena defeating the Hurricanes 5-1. Brennan Silk scored the only Halton goal to break the Husky shutout, assisted by Chris Alarie. Goaltending duties were shared by Jeff Wiggins and Nick Pliotas.

Less than 30 seconds after the opening face-off of game two, Joel Petkoff deked out the opposing goaltender to give Halton a quick lead. Jarrett Konkle had the next one for the Hurricanes on a pass from defenseman Jordan Jeans, but Hamilton soon tied the score on two powerplay goals.

In the third period, Chris Alarie netted the go-ahead goal with help from Konkle and Petkoff, and when

Hamilton pulled their goalie moments later, it was an easy target for Jeff Brownlee to end it at 4-2.

It was back to Hamilton for game three and Halton won it 7-3. Jarrett Konkle banged in a hat trick for the Hurricanes, Jeff Brownlee had two goals and singles were netted by Chris Alarie and Joel Petkoff. Jordan Jeans picked up four assists and other assists were credited to Carter Trevisani, Matt Walinga and Brydon Butterworth. The defensive lineup of Trevisani, Butterworth, Jeans and Michael Knoepfli, and goaltender Nick Pliotas frustrated the Husky forwards time and time again as they kept all but three shots out of their net.

Playing at Tonelli Arena March 17 against tough, determined opponents and missing one of their key players, The Fero Waste Disposal Crew fought hard but it was a losing battle as Hamilton won it 6-4 to stay alive and force a fifth and deciding game.

Halton's offense was led by Jeff

Brownlee with two goals. Mike Austen and Joel Petkoff with one each. Dylan Hardy, Mike Knoepfli, Jordan Jeans, Chris Alarie and Jarrett Konkle worked hard to earn their assists.

It was a tense atmosphere for game five played at Hamilton's Eastwood Arena March 20 as the game remained close until the third period. Jeff Brownlee scored first for Halton but Hamilton replied soon after. Jarrett Konkle scored next for Halton on a pass from Joel Petkoff. Mike Austen scored an insurance goal midway through the third period, and with some great backchecking, amazing defense by Brydon Butterworth, Jeans and Knoepfli and outstanding goaltending by Nick Pliotas, Halton managed to keep their opponents off the scoreboard for the remainder of the game. Jarrett Konkle fired the puck into the empty net and seconds later, the buzzer went to tend the series. The final score was 4-1.

The Hurricanes now play Peterborough for the Ontario Minor Hockey Association Championship. Game one was in Peterborough on Sunday. Unfortunately, Halton lost 3-1. Game two is at the Erin Community Centre at 7:00 p.m. tonight (Wednesday). Game three will be back at Peterborough on Friday evening and game four is scheduled for Erin again, at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday.

The Halton Hurricane Minor Atom team has three players from Georgetown, Brydon Butterworth, Michael Knoepfli and Matt Walinga.
