High Averages

CLUB LENGTH

One of the biggest myths in a golfer's mind is the notion that taller golfers need longer clubs and shorter players need shorter clubs.

This is not necessarily so. Length in all but very unusual circumstances should be determined by what the golfer feels most comfortable and confident with Also, a golfer's playing ability and coordination are key factors.

A tall golfer (6'3") who has a hard time hitting the ball solid on the centre of the clubface may be better off with standard length clubs.

On the other hand, a shorter golfer (5'6") who hits the ball solid and on the centre of the clubface may want to try 1/2" to 1" longer than standard clubs to increase distance. Increased club length will usually increase distance.

There is one consideration, however the ball must be hit on the centre of the clubface. The longer the club, the harder it is to hit the ball in the centre of the clubface, and the distance lost from off centre hits is quite substantial.
