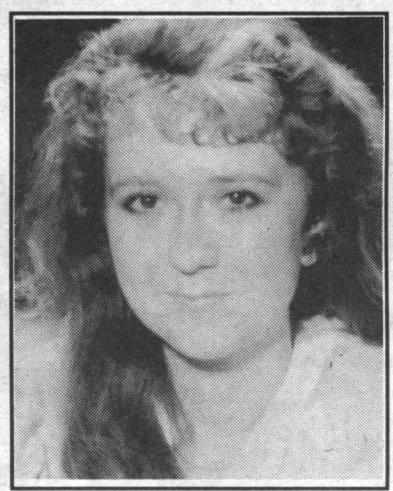
A breath of Scotland in The Hills

Fire in the Sky
 Directed by Robert Lieberman, Fire in the Sky is based on the "true" story of Travis Walton of Arizona, who was abducted by an alien force in front of his friends. Unable to accept the alien abduction story, the local authorities placed Walton's friends under murder charges. Walton is played by DB Sweeney. Watch for a strong performance by

Robert Patrick (Terminator 2) who plays Walton's friend. (Rated PG, with coarse language).

Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles III

Fans of the Japanese Shogun movies may appreciate the parody on these movies that the heroes on the half-shell bring in their latest production — Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles III. Anyway, it may help you to get through what is a big hit with the kids. Out of the New York sewers, the turtles are thrown through time-travel to feudal Japan where their martial arts are put to use. They are also successful in confounding the warring feudal folks with the latest slang and dietary habits. (Rated PG).

Cop and a Half

This is definitely one for the under-12 crowd. Cop and a Half, directed by Henry Winkler (yes, the Fonz himself!) stars Burt Reynolds as a burnt-out cop teamed with a street-wise eight-year-old, played by Norman D. Golden II, who has witnessed a murder. (Rated PG).
