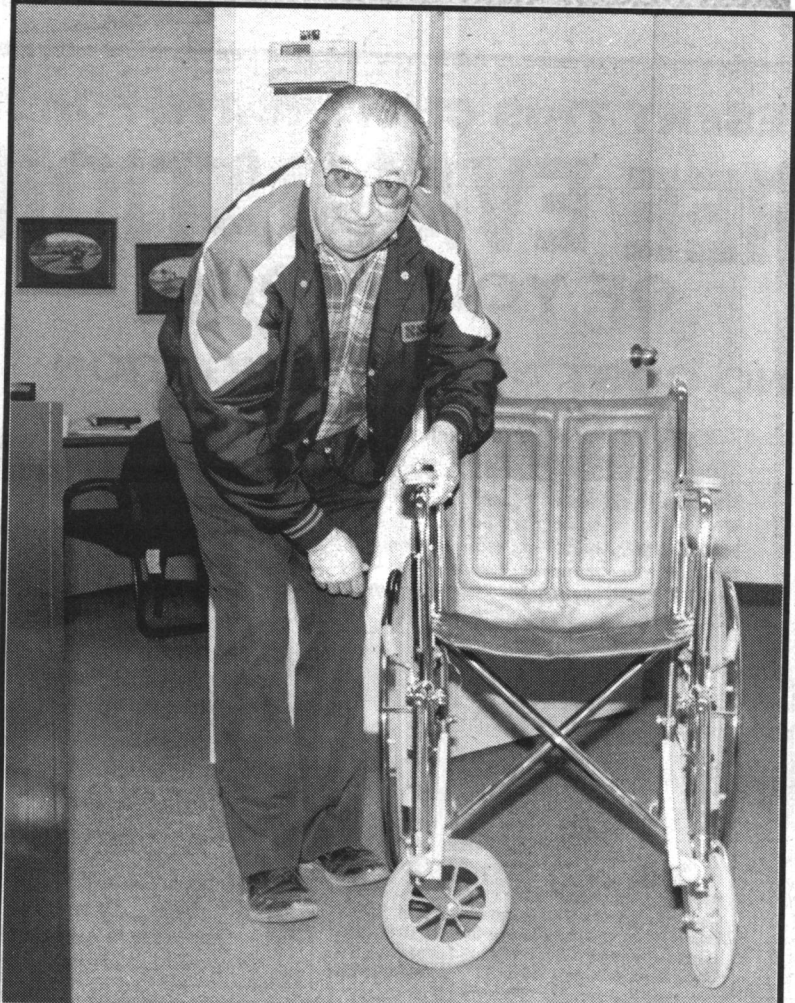

Soft toy-making requires patience

When making soft toys, your regular needlecraft equipment can be used plus useful additions of a curved upholstery needle for sewing on external features; a blunt pencil or stick for dealing with the stuffing; and a pair of compasses for drawing and sizing up shapes.

securely. The best stuffing is polyester fibre fill. It is washable, non-allergenic and easy to use. Non-flammable shredded yarn or fabric can also be used.

The main priority in toy-making is to avoid any materials or accessories which conceivably harm a child.

After you have finished cutting out your sewing project, the remaining fabric can be cut into 6" squares and stored until you have enough to make into yardage to create something new. In the meantime, I would not be burdened with storing what appears to be rags.

If the toy is to be washed, stick to fur fabric, closely woven tweeds, suiting, heavy cotton and linen scraps. Felt may be used for features, but it does not wash well.

HOME FRONT TIP: To prevent shower curtains from forming any mildew, soak in a solution of salt water before putting them up for use.

For accessories, use felt yarn, lace and ribbons for trimming. Eyes can be made from buttons, or manufactured wiggly eyes as long as they are plastic lock-in type with safety washers.
