

# Out at the Ranch

### THE SHOW

I recently had the distinct pleasure, once again, of touring the Annual Wine and Cheese Show at the International Centre. This has become somewhat of a tradition with daughter Becky and husband Kevin. It is some show! If you have not visited this show, I would highly recommend a

When you lay out your ten bucks, you get admission and a small wine glass. Make sure you hang onto that glass - you will need it! Oh yes - buy lots of tickets to exchange for your samples. We always go on a Saturday afternoon and even then, the crowds are dense, but aisles are wide so you can move around with ease.

This year we set up a system to rendezvous our group, in case someone got left behind in the crowd or got lost. We found that a wine glass firmly clutched in the hand with arm fully extended upwards worked very well. We recovered each person that strayed from the group.

With the great array of foods and drinks available for sampling, we found it wise to pace ourselves on what to sample. Booths and products are not in any particular rotation. So you can experience English beer, vintage wines, Italian cheese and pizza, all in a matter of a few feet of aisle. Take pity of your poor stomach!

I suggest that you go around the show twice to help you put your sampling into some semblance of order. Maybe you will want to sample some beers and hardy foods first. Then sample some of those gorgeous, unknown to you, wines. There are rinse stations all around so you can renew your glass for the next wine surprise. Now move on to the cheeses. Wow! Then how about a

little dish of great pasta with some exotic sauce. Or try those delicious looking chicken

wings and shrimp something or other. Many of the manufacturers not only sample at the show, they also sell their products at generally attractive prices. You will, most likely walk out with a loaf of delectable garlic bread, a jar of decadent salad dressing, a package of pasta, in a shape and colour new to you. Maybe a wedge of Italian cheese, name impossible to pronounce, or maybe a little caviar, if you are so inclined.

You may wish to try one or two of the exotic libations that are available. Little shots of Tequila are there - for the hardy! Or how about a flamed Sambucca - very classy! And then I saw a sign that said, in bold print. mind you - "Sex on the Beach" Can you believe that? And no one seemed shocked! Pretty racey stuff for your faithful reporter from the boonies! My daughter assured me it was only a raspberry liqueur over crushed ice. Not bad!

A couple of things not to miss, though I'm certain many could be listed. A sample of "Screech" from the Newfoundland Liquor Board. And, by all means, share a small fillet of Arctic Char on a bed of wild rice. with a dry Vermouth sauce. Schmecks!

We covered the show in about three hours, though you could easily spend double that amount of time. Don't plan to prepare any of your favorite dishes for a couple of days, after visiting the show. It will take at least a day for your taste buds to settle back into their normal pattern.
