Jones and Jans superb in squash play

The Ontario provincial Junior squash championships were held April 16-18 at the White Oaks Racquet Club, outside of St. Catharines. Andrew Jones of Georgetown participated in the under-12 division along with 29 other contenders.

In a best-ever performance, Andrew not only reached the final, but pushed the number one ranked player, Chris Hanaberry, of Ajax,

Ontario to the limit.

The players alternated game victories and give the crown a thrilling finish, with Hanaberry finally pulling out the win 9-7 in the 5th set. With the confidence he has gained from his close 2nd-place finish, Andrew is looking forward to a rematch at the nationals, to be held in Calgary in May.

In the meantime, Georgetown's Melanie Jans competed in a Men's "A" Tournament at the Toronto Athletic Squash Club.

She achieved her best-ever result

in an event of this caliber by winning 4 out of 5 matches.

Although she lost her second round in a tough five-game battle, she won her next two matches, thus earning the right to play in the consolation final.

She then eked out a five-game win against Meadowvale squash professional Bill Guest.

Melanie is preparing for the national championships, to be held in Kamloops, B.C. later this month. She is currently ranked third in Canada.
