a sizable backlog. He said the planner would be needed for one year, and that approximately \$50,000 would be necessary for hiring the individual.

Heaton recommended the planning department search for other solutions to the backlog problem and report back to the council's 1994 budget committee. He added that if a firm or individual is hired, they should not have been previously engaged in development in

the region or the town, and that they should not be allowed to work in the private sector of either location after the one year contract is up.

Councillors agreed with Keith that another senior planner should be hired, but opposed Heaton's amendments and voted against his suggested changes concerning Keith's request.

where this co-operation has been accomplished, a measurable decrease in the rate of crime has been noted.

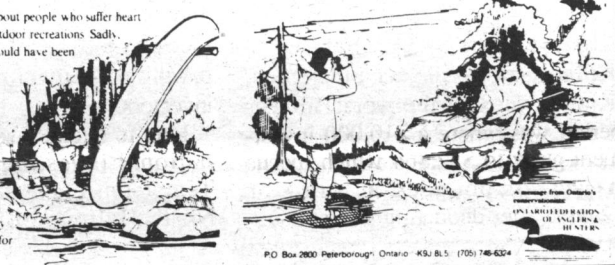
