**WHAT HAPPENS AFTER EFILE?**

Now that the personal income tax return filing date has passed and those of you, who filed your return electronically, have already spent your refund or are expecting it shortly, please keep in mind the following points.

**Changing your return**  
• Once your return has been electronically filed, it cannot be changed electronically. If you want to change your return, send Revenue Canada a letter with the necessary supporting documents, to the taxation centre serving your area.

**Verification**  
• All individual income tax returns, whether they are electronically filed or paper filed, undergo a routine review process to ensure that they have been properly assessed. This review program takes place after the returns have been initially assessed.

• If Revenue Canada selects your return for review, you will receive a letter asking for specific documents to support your claim or claims. The review process does not necessarily mean that there are any errors or omissions on your part, or on the part of your EFILE agent.

• Revenue Canada will address all correspondence to you, unless you authorize a representative to discuss your tax affairs with them. To authorize a representative, please send Consent Form T1013 to Revenue Canada. Your agent can explain more about this process.

**Record to keep**  
• You have to keep all information slips, receipts, and other documents used to prepare your tax return.

• Both you and your EFILE agent have to keep a copy of form T183. This is the form you signed to authorize your EFILE agent to electronically file your 1992 return, and to verify the accuracy of the information reported.

• Please keep all records for six years.
