# Hospital board wants rep. changes

At the Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital board of directors meeting May 18, a motion was passed to cut the number of representatives from Town of Halton Hills council by half. Presently, two councillors are appointed from the candidates proposed by the town. If more than two concillors are recommended, the hospital board votes on who will sit on the

Connel Smith, chair of the hospital board, insists the recomendation does not reflect the board's dissatisfaction with the work done by the municipal councillors. "The're doing a good job," Smith maintains.

Presently 20 members sit on the board - 12 elected and 8 ex-officio. The municipal councillors fall into the ex-officio category. Smith explained the hospital wants to

members, to "increase the coupling to other agencies in town," without altering the number of board members in general.

"As well as the two councillors, we have town representation from Marilyn Serjeantson, even though she's technically a representative of the region," Smith said.

"The reason we want to pass the by-law is to have the ability to appoint members from community organizations, to have greater rep-

Councillor Robert Heaton who, along with Councillor Ron Chatten, is a town representative on the board, disagrees with Smith's explanation. Heaton believes the hospital is retaliating about his protest on the issue of paid parking. "I prevented them from obtaining a unanimous decision. I think the provided explanation is, um...hogwash."


