REVENUE CANADA IGNORANCE IS NO DEFENSE

As part of the "Income Tax Fairness Package", Revenue Canada has the discretion to waive penalties or interest in respect of income tax for the 1985 or subsequent taxation years. Requests for reductions of penalties or interest should be made in writing to Revenue Canada in unfair situations.

Examples of situations where Revenue Canada has said they would consider waiving penalties or interest include:

1. natural or human-made disasters such as flood or fire,
2. civil disturbance or disruption in services, such as a strike,
3. serious illness or accident which prevented the timely filing of a tax return or making of a payment, and
4. erroneous information from Revenue Canada in the form of incorrect written answers or errors in published information.

However, if the delay in payment or compliance is due to neglect or lack of awareness on the part of the taxpayer, the penalty or interest will not be waived.

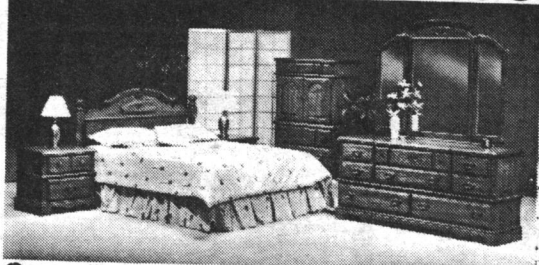
