BARBEQUE SAFETY



CHARCOAL BARBEQUES

- * Always use barbeque lighter fluid to light the charcoal.
- * Never add barbeque lighter fluid to charcoal that is already burning.
- * Put water on the coals when you're finished.
- * Put ashes or coals in a non-combustible container for disposal.

PROPANE BARBEOUES

- * Always check the hose connections for leaks with soap and water after you install the propane cylinder.
- * Be sure the lid is open before lighting the barbeque.
- * Be sure the cylinder valve is fully off when the barbeque is not in use.
- * Be sure the barbeque is cool before covering and storing it.
- * Always store propane cylinders outside in well ventilated areas.
