

UPDATE OF ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS IN HALTON

On June 9, 1993, Regional Council adopted the results of the Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA) Study (1993) as the basis for incorporating new ESA boundaries into the New Regional Official Plan. The 1993 ESA study is an important background study supporting the New Regional Official Plan.

Regional Council is currently reviewing the Regional Official Plan, a legal document that guides the physical development of the Region. A Draft New Regional Plan was released for public discussion in March 1993. Several public open houses and workshops were held during the months of March to May 1993.

The map below shows the existing ESA's, additions to existing ESA's and new ESA's.





Plans for the Georgetown Downtown Market are moving right along. On June 11, the vending permit was granted, and all that's left before the July 3 opening is a few finishing touches on the building and the search for a few more vendors.

"I'm surprised we received the license so soon," said Natalie Ramakers, market manager. "I was told it would take six to eight weeks for the application to be processed. I was in every day, seeing if the permit was ready. I think they gave it to me just to get me out


of their way."
