Learn to Speak Effectively

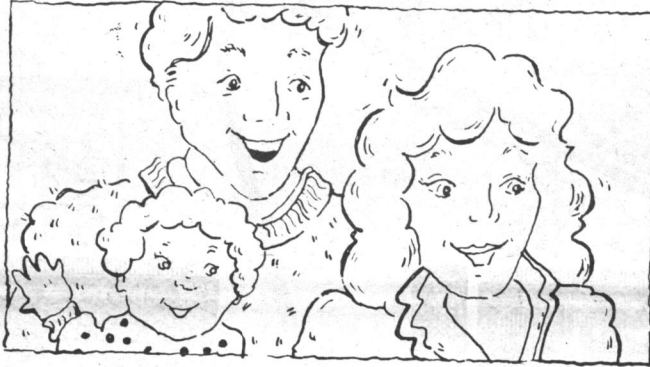
