Thirteen years ago, on April 12, 1980 in St. John's, Newfoundland, Terry Fox began his Marathon of Hope - the hope for a cure for cancer. He ran 5,564 km in 143 days before his run was halted due to cancer spreading to his lungs. Although his life sadly ended on June 28, 1981, one month short of his 23rd birthday, his dream has never died.
