There is a great deal to "Much Ado"

Much Ado About Nothing is filmmaker Kenneth Branagh's eagerly-anticipated second venture into the works of William Shakespeare. The result is a lush, bawdy, sensual film that jumps off the screen. Much Ado About Nothing is masterpiece.

Producer, director, writer and actor Kenneth Branagh presents Shakespeare the way he was meant to, presented with passion and vibrance and not as homework in a class-

Much Ado About Nothing is simply the story of two courtships. Branagh and reallife wife, Emma Thompson, portray Benedick and Beatrice, a couple who mask their true feelings behind wisecracks and witticisms. The parallel love story is between Claudio (Robert Sean Leonard) and Hero (Kate Beckinsale). Their love consists of soft looks and flowery words. Throw in a

well-meaning noble Don Pedro (Denzel Washington) and a bastard brother, Don John (Keanu Reeves) and you'll see why love's road is anything but smooth.

For much of his adult life, Branagh has traveled the world with his own Theatre Company performing the works of Shakespeare. Branagh knows that the greatness of Shakespeare comes from his words. Therefore, Branagh directs with a passive camera. There are no grand camera movements that threaten to overwhelm the dialogue. Instead, with soft and lingering movement, the camera drinks in every delicious word spoken.

Branagh and Thompson are superb in the film's most pivotal roles. Branagh creates a Benedick who is at times gullible, sarcastic, romantic


and heroic. Thompson is equal to the task. Her Beatrice is outspoken and witty, as well as sincere. These fine performances allow the film

to bounce between comedy

and drama effortlessly. The obvious brilliance of both Branagh and Thompson point to the film's only flaw. So comfortable with the material are these two, they make the American actors appear weak, but this is only a minor point.

Special mention must be made of cinematographer Roger Lander, whose use of pastel tones gives a rich and unforgettable look to the film.

In a 1991 interview, Branagh said "I don't see myself as a filmmaker. I feel like a bit of an impostor in the role". With the release of Much Ado About Nothing, there is no doubt Kenneth Branagh is well on the way to becoming one of the leading filmmakers of our generation.





