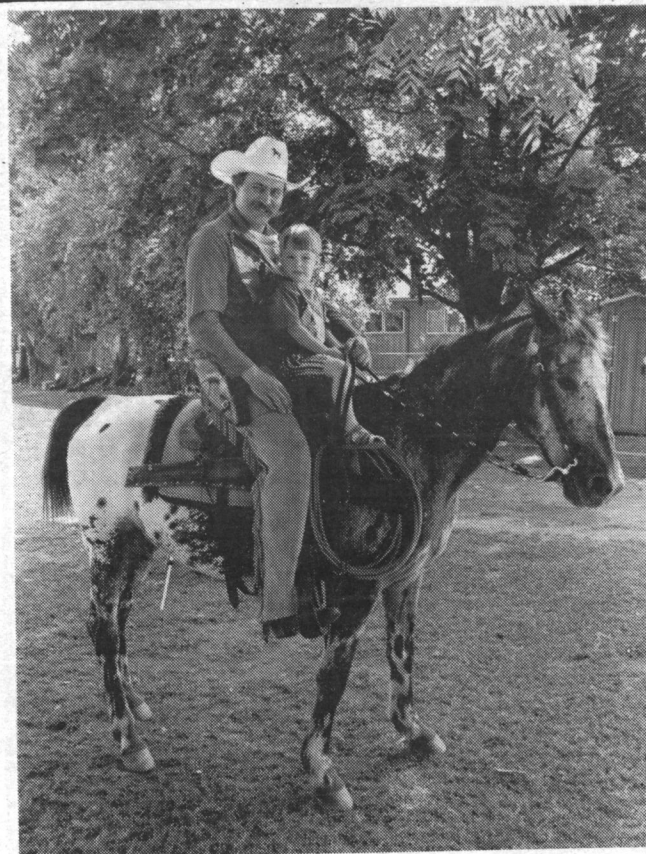

STAR

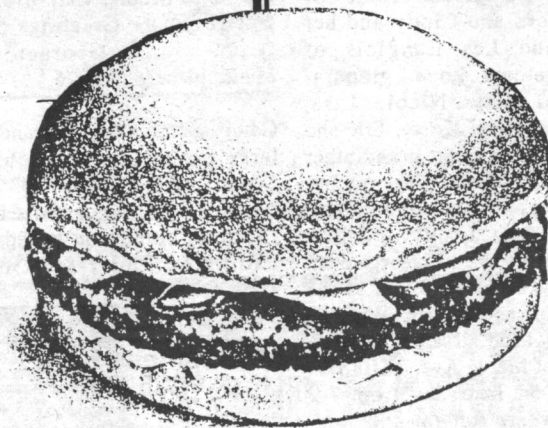
The first star in the sky
