Some of the charges,

including fail to appear, impaired driving, having over the legal limit of alcohol, and causing a disturbance, dated back to 1975.

The man will appear in Milton Provincial Court Aug. 16 for the gun-related charges, and will appear later in Peel Region Court for the former charges.




