RECIPE STRAWBERRY TEA BREAD

3 eggs	1 tsp. salt
1 cup sugar	1 tsp. baking soda
1 cup salad oil	1/2 tsp. baking powder
1 tbsp. vanilla	1 1/2 cups quick oats
2 cups flour	2 cups crushed strawberries fresh or frozen.
1 tsp. cinnamon	

Beat eggs and sugar, add oil and vanilla. Sift together flour, cinnamon, salt, baking soda, and baking powder. Mix in oats. Mix dry ingredients into egg mixture. Add crushed strawberries and mix well. Pour into 2 greased and floured 8" x 4" loaf pans. Bake for 45 minutes at 375°F. Freeze or well.
