New additions to Police Services Board

Halton's Regional Police Services Board (HRPSB) swore in a new member at the Thursday morning meeting at Halton Region Police Service Headquarters on Bronte Rd. in Oakville, and will be swearing in another member in less than a month's time.

Richard Szymczyk became the newest commissioner on the board. The appointment of the retired Burlington educator was sanctioned by Solicitor-General David Christopherson in an Orderin-Council issued on May 12. "I'm surprised this has happened so quickly," Barry Quinn, chair of the HRPSB admitted.



provincially-Another appointed board member, Paul Lafleur, a Burlington lawyer, will be performing the swearing-in ceremony immediately prior to the HRPSB meeting.

Oakville councillor Fred Oliver will be sworn in at the Aug. 19 meeting. Oliver was elected by Halton Regional Council. Four members of the board are appointed by the province, and three are elected by the region.

The current six-member board includes Szymczyk; Quinn, also a regional councillor; Town of Halton Hills Mayor Russ Miller; and provincial appointees from Burlington - Lafleur, Halton Hills - Lucy Quaglia, and Milton - Wendy Roberts.

Quinn previously said he would like to see a full board by September, so it can proceed with its current task of selecting a new police chief to replace Chief James Harding, who will be retiring next year for health-related reasons.




