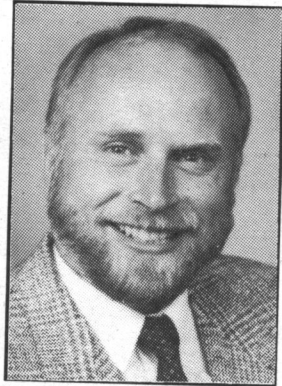

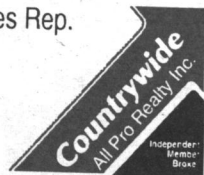

League leaders leaving pack behind

The rich got richer and the rest of the pack could soon find themselves left scrapping for third place bragging rights, as a result of games played last Sunday at GDHS in the Georgetown Men's Flag Football League.

Dawgs ripped through M&M Pro Sports, 64-13; Muscle Pit couldn't find enough players and defaulted to Meznic Electric, while the Longhorns trampled Plus Welding, 42-0.

Paul Martin and Marcus Noel of Plus Welding join Bob Davey of Longhorns atop the interception ladder, each has three.

M&M looked thoroughly confused on both offence and defence and were never a factor in this lopsided affair.

Dawgs led 32-0 at the half and added a matching 32 points during second half play.

Seven Dawgs shared in the scoring parade, led by Al Pelland, who had 18 points. Shifty John Egan had 14 points; Serge Lebel counted 12 points; Terry Enman and Mike DelGuidice each scored eight points, while Duane Wilson and Tim Wysocki each added two-point converts.

DelGuidice picked off an errant M&M pass in the first half, then walked in front of an attempted M&M lateral on a kickoff return in the second half to give his teammates one more kick at the cat.

Brian Boettger and Roger Thomas had the M&M majors, with Mark McKeon kicking a long single.

Longhorns 42 Plus Welding 0

Longhorns started slowly and held a relatively slim 14-0 lead at the half.

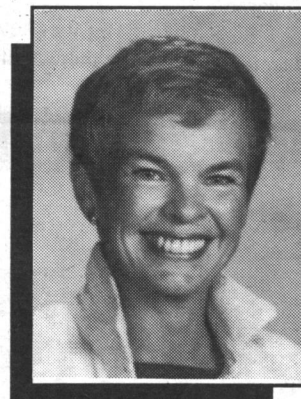
