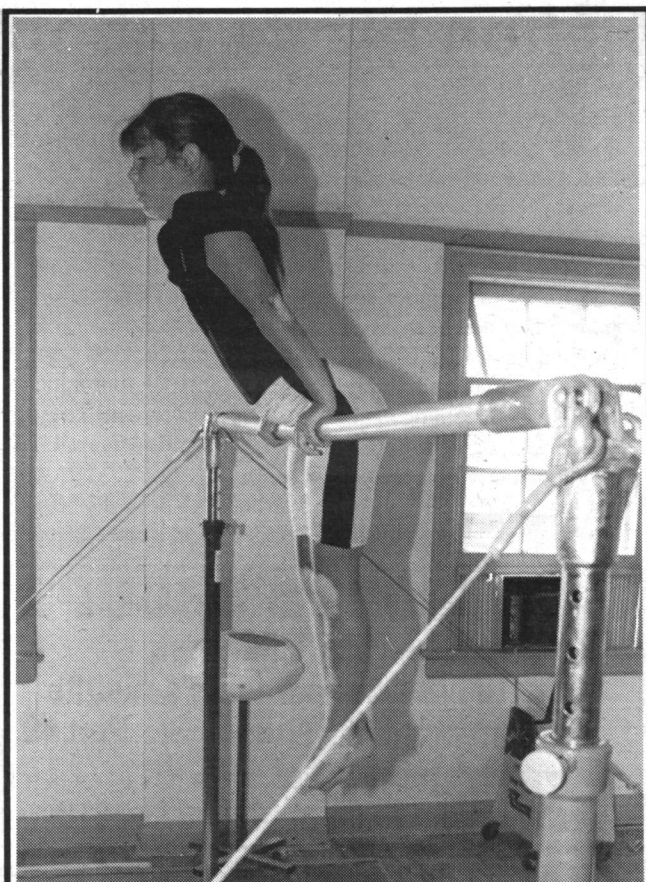

Mike James contributed to the offensive effort by going 3-for-3 at the plate

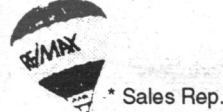
