Halton council wants the Ontario government to account to municipalities for provincial spending and rev-

At a special meeting, regional council decided to ask Premier Bob Rae to explain why his government has introduced new programs and program enhancements at a time when municipalities are being forced by the province to make extremely difficult budget cuts.

The meeting had been called so that council could give its approval to a plan which will cut nearly millions from regional spending in compliance with the provincial expenditure control program and social con-

However, the meeting also gave councillors the dismay with new provincial programs.

"We keep hearing announcements of new programs," Halton Hills Councillor Marilyn Serjeantson said. Council is willing to do its part to reduce spending, she said, but she would like to know what kind of job the province is doing.

"I can understand their frustration," Oakville South MPP Gary Carr said.

"Percentage-wise, the municipalities have made

province. There is still a tremendous amount of waste in provincial government."

Carr said figures released June 30 show that the province spent \$2 million more than it had budgeted for the first quarter of the fiscal year.

bigger cuts than the enues were down \$55 million because fewer taxes than estimated were collected from corporations, tobacco sales and land transfers.
