### HOW DO CHLORINE AND BROMINE KILL BACTERIA IN MY POOL AND SPA?

~ PART 2 ~

Both chlorine and bromine are an important first step in keeping your investment a safe and healthy one. Chlorine, in nearly every type, forms hypochlorous acid in water. This reaction dependent on the pH level. When using chlorine, the ideal pH is between 7.4 and 7.6. If pH drops, more hypochlorous acid is formed. Likewise, bromine forms hypobromous acid. But this reaction is not as pH dependent. In a brominated pool, more hypobromous acid is present at pH 8.0. Both hypochlorous acid and hypobromous acid kill bacteria and other undesirable organisms in much the same way. Here's a brief explanation. All cells need certain enzymes to live. Hypochlorous acid and hypobromous acid move through the bacteria cell's membrane and inactivate some of these enzymes. The result? Within just milliseconds of contact, bacteria is dead. Some bacteria are smarter than others and have devised a protective "slime layer". For these types, higher concentrations of either sanitizer are necessary. You will also need to brush these types to break the slime layer and allow the sanitizer to do its job.

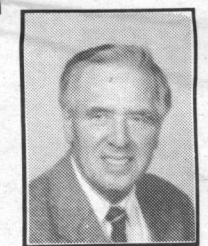

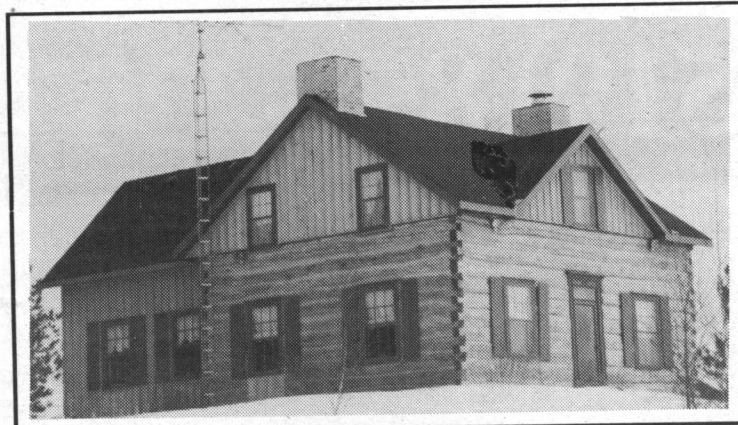
