RECIPE

STRAWBERRY TEA BREAD

3 eggs	1 tsp. salt
1 cup sugar	1 tsp. baking soda
1 cup salad oil	1/2 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp. vanilla	1 1/2 cups quick oats
2 cups flour	2 cups crushed strawberries fresh or frozen.
1 tsp. cinnamon	

Beat eggs and sugar, add oil and vanilla. Sift together flour, cinnamon, salt, baking soda, and baking powder. Mix in oats. Mix dry ingredients into egg mixture. Add crushed strawberries and mix well. Pour into 2 greased and floured 8" x 4" loaf pans. Bake for 45 minutes at 375°F. Freezes well.

RECIPE

STRAWBERRY CREAM TARTS

Filling: 1 pkg Vanilla Pudding Mix (cooked type)	cream	1 tbsp. orange rind & 2 tbsp. orange juice
1 1/2 cup milk	2 tbsp. corn starch	1 cup whole strawberries
1/2 cup whipping	1/2 cup sugar (white)	
	1 cup berries cut up	

Make vanilla pudding as directed on package using 1 1/2 cup milk, chill. Whip cream stiff and fold into pudding. Spoon into baked shells, chill. Combine cornstarch and sugar in saucepan, add cut up berries, orange rind and juice. Cook over

low heat mashing berries and stirring until thick and clear - cool slightly. Put whole berries on top of vanilla pudding in tart shells, spoon cornstarch mixture over top. Chill.
