## Phoney money

Counterfeit U.S. bills are becoming a more serious concern in Halton Region. "This is definitely becoming a problem here and in surrounding municipalities," said Detective Sergeant Mike Kingston of the Halton Regional Police Services. He added during the past month, more than 15 counterfeit \$50 and \$100 bills were passed in Halton Hills and Milton.

Kingston advises people dealing with the currency to keep an American bill on hand with which they can compare customers' currency, or direct customers to the nearest bank, where staff is more qualified to distinguish between counterfeit and legitimate bills.

On Aug. 5, a man passed a counterfeit \$100 at a roadside fruit stand on 17 Side Road and Winston Churchill Blvd. in Halton Hills. Police are looking for a white male, in his mid-30s, who was driving a white GMC pick-up truck.

process of 10 contracts which he knew of.

"This had better be solved before someone sues for loss of income due to non-performance," Burnett said.

Counc. Rob Heaton agreed with Burnett. Heaton familiarized councillors at a meeting last week with the Class Proceedings Act, passed at the beginning of the year, which will make it easier for individuals who have banded together as a result of common grievances to sue for damages.

"I believe we should take notice of this correspondence (Burnett's letter) and effect changes within the department, seeking improvements in service equal to the standard of neighboring municipalities," Heaton said.

Municipal administrator, Ray King, attributed the delays to a problem of staffing and announced a temporary plans examiner has been hired.

Counc.Al Cook speculated another reason may be that Halton Hills seems to have more construction taking place than other municipalities. "We're (Halton Hills) still vibrant
