General Committee for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a public meeting to examine and discuss a proposed amendment to Town By-law's 86-143, 88-139 and 57-91 relating to the community of Georgetown and in particular, the Georgetown South area as identified on the above map.

The proposed amendments to the zoning by-laws involve the following:

- consideration of a revised plan of subdivision (24T-84013) for 231 single-family residential lots on land described as part of lots 11, and 12, Concession 9, Town of Halton Hills (Georgetown),
- consideration of a Part Lot Control application to permit the subdivision of Block 104, Plan 20M-573, Town of Halton Hills (Georgetown) into 6 single family residential lots, and
- consideration of a Part Lot Control Application to permit the subdivision of Block 99, Plan 20M-573, Town of Halton Hills (Georgetown) into 110 townhouse dwelling lots.

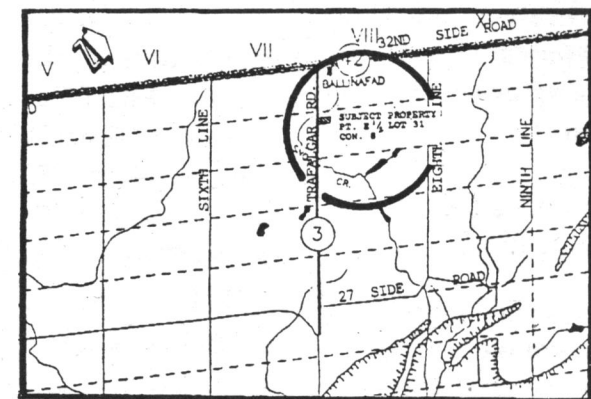

VIA RAIL ACROSS CANADA

VIA Rail's Silver & Blue Class service aboard the recently refurbished Canadian between Toronto and Vancouver offers passengers top-notch service and an unforgettable journey that covers rugged Northern Ontario, the Prairies, the Rocky Mountains and the beautiful Pacific Coast. Eastbound and westbound departures are scheduled three times each week. The trip can be split into segments, allowing passengers to disembark and discover the area around Winnipeg, Saskatoon, Edmonton, Jasper or Kamloops.

In refurbishing the original stainless steel Canadian fleet, VIA retained its distinctive art deco style but incorporated modern technology and materials to enhance the ride. While each sleeping car has a shower, small closet, hand basin, fold-down table and separate toilet with shower, most passengers prefer to spend the day in the Park Car. Its three separate salons include the dome, which offers sweeping views, the Bullet Lounge with wrap around windows and afternoon tea service or the Mural Lounge where games are played. A separate dining car has three dinner sittings.

For travellers wishing to see Eastern Canada, VIA Rail has service aboard its Transcontinentals from Montreal through the St. Lawrence River Valley and Gaspé Peninsula to the Maritimes. Service aboard the Transcontinentals include bedroom accommodation, sections (with conversion to bunk bed with a curtain for privacy) and one-person rooms with sleeping area, wash basin, toilet and razor outlet.
