Continued from page 4 efforts of the provincial government to create garbage dumps in Halton-Peel instead of looking at the alternatives, which are so readily available.

This may not be perceived as a federal issue except that a ruling by an Ontario judge will allow the case to be contested in the Supreme Court of Canada. All elected people who serve the public should be equally concerned about the environment and about decisions which affect it.

There are no specifically federal, provincial or municipal environmental • challenges, nor are there any specifically federal, provincial or municipal citizens. There is only one taxpayer and only one environment, and people who are elected to serve the public must be aware the days of passing on responsibility from one area of government to another are over.

Canada is a country of great diversity. My personal belief is that a strong federal government, prag-

The chief surgeon and the recovery team should be as experienced as possible.Ten years in the Ontario Legislature, serving four shadow cabinet portfolios is a good start.






