Promar Karate cleans up

Members of Promar Karate of Georgetown (318 Guelph St., telephone 877-9009) have been competing in the U.S. over the summer and came home with an impressive number of wins. The most recent outing was Aug. 6 & 7 in Buffalo, New York at the Can-Am Karate Classic. Four Georgetown Black Belts brought back eight trophies.

Chief Instructor Mark Yates took 1st place in Black Belt Men's Self-Defense. This win places Sensei Yates as the #1 Canadian Adult Self-Defense Competitor and #4 Internationally - as rated by Sport Karate International. Black Belt James Harrison took 2nd in Junior Black Belt Self-Defense and 4th in Junior Black Belt Sparring.

Black Belt Derek Harrison took 2nd place in 13-14-yearold Black Belt Sparring. Chief Instructor Deborah Crispin was 3rd in Ladies Black Belt Weapons and 4th in Ladies Black Belt Sparring and Kata. Sensie Crispin also took 2nd in Sparring in Cleveland, Ohio in late July and a 3rd, 4th and 5th in Weapons, Kata and Sparring in an earlier June Buffalo tournament.

The Promar Karate crew has just started back on the tournament scene after a three-year layoff. "Raising a young family and building a strong club took up a lot of time. Now at the new location things are running smoothly, giving us more time to compete" said Sensie Crispin.
